Xpress Wellness Announces Plans to Build Urgent Care Medical Center

ENID, OK -- Xpress Wellness announced plans to build a state-of-the art urgent care medical center in Enid, Oklahoma. The new urgent care medical center will be located at 220 S. Van Buren and begin seeing patients in March 2014. Enid is the second location announced this month. Elk City location was announced earlier. Henson Construction Company will build both facilities and plans to start construction by the end of August.

Xpress Wellness has formed a medical services agreement with St. Mary's Regional Medical Center to staff the Enid medical center with local physicians and mid-level providers. Stan Tatum, CEO for St. Mary's said, "We are excited to partner with Xpress Wellness and provide urgent care medical services for Enid and surrounding communities."

Xpress Wellness is an urgent care and occupational medicine provider that treats non-life threatening illnesses and injuries on a walk-in basis (no appointment needed). Xpress Wellness will be open 7 days a week with extended evening hours and weekend services.

The urgent care center will consist of 8 private exam rooms which include a procedure room, triage room and ability to provide women's health care. The center will have computerized radiology services, lab services, diagnostic testing and EKG onsite. Comprehensive medical care services will be provided including care for common illnesses, sprains, strains, lacerations, flu, allergies, infections, pediatric care, vaccinations, sports physicals, work physicals, drug screens, and work-related injuries. Insurance and other forms of payment will be accepted.

Xpress Wellness is an Oklahoma-based privately held company led by Dr. Scott Williams, Geoff Helm and Brian Hayden. Dr. Williams graduated from Oklahoma State University of Osteopathic Medicine and is board certified through American Board of Osteopathic Family Practitioners. He is Chief of Staff for Great Plains Regional Medical Center. He has been in family practice in Elk City since 1999 with special interests in obstetrics and sports medicine. Xpress Wellness plans to open its first 10 urgent care medical centers by the end of 2016. Enid and Elk City will be its first two locations.
