Xpress Wellness Urgent Care Announces Plans to Build Third Location

WEATHERFORD, OK -- Xpress Wellness announced plans to build a state-of-the art urgent care medical center in Weatherford, Oklahoma. The new urgent care medical center will be located at 1303 N. Washington and expects to begin seeing patients in September 2014. Weatherford is the third Oklahoma location for Xpress Wellness – following Enid and Elk City. Henson Construction Company will build the facility and plans to start construction by the end of April 2014.

Xpress Wellness is an urgent care and occupational medicine provider that treats non-life threatening illnesses and injuries on a walk-in basis (no appointment needed). Xpress Wellness is open 7 days a week with extended evening hours and weekend services. In addition to high quality medical care, Xpress Wellness focuses on convenient services and reducing wait times. Services include “get in line” with online check-in option that allows patients to wait at home or where they are most comfortable. Online check-in feature is accessible through the company’s website www.XpressWellnessUrgentCare.com. Patients are able to fill commonly prescribed non-narcotic medicine onsite following their medical visit.

The urgent care center will consist of six private exam rooms, triage room and a procedure room. The center will have computerized radiology services, lab services, diagnostic testing and EKG onsite. Comprehensive medical care services will be provided including care for common illnesses, sprains, strains, lacerations, flu, allergies, infections, pediatric care, vaccinations, sports physicals, work physicals, drug screens, and work-related injuries. Insurance and other forms of payment will be accepted.

Xpress Wellness is a privately-held company based in Enid, Oklahoma. The company is led by Dr. Scott Williams (Chief Medical Officer) and Brian Hayden (President). Dr. Williams graduated from Oklahoma State University College of Osteopathic Medicine and is board certified through American Board of Osteopathic Family Practitioners. Prior to assuming his position as Chief Medical Officer, Dr. Williams served as Chief of Staff for Great Plains Regional Medical Center and operated a family practice in Elk City. Xpress Wellness has made additional site selections and completed architectural designs for future urgent care medical centers in Shawnee and Muskogee, OK. Xpress Wellness will have seven urgent care centers in operation by the end of 2014.
